



Anti-Bullying Video Contest

Participation for all MKC-MCOS pageants is required.

Developing, designing and researching the theme, can give you a voice in your community on important bullying issues. Good videos can tell important stories and the right message will capture attention and inspire your community.

Contest Rules:

- ❖ Video 2 to 5 minutes in length that best communicates themes and issues associated with anti-bullying including physical bullying, verbal bullying, covert or hidden bullying (this sort of bullying is often harder to recognize and can be carried out behind the bullied person's back. It is designed to harm someone's social reputation and/or cause humiliation) and cyberbullying.
- ❖ Your video can be a monologue, scene, animation, picture collage with voiceover, etc.
- ❖ Must be original work
- ❖ Must be created by individual contestant

Entries will be evaluated on the following criteria:

- ❖ All videos will be uploaded to the Miss Klamath County-Miss City of Sunshine Scholarship Pageant Facebook page and will be voted on by the public (which will account for ½ of the total points). The videos will also be viewed by the benefactors of this scholarship and their vote will count for the other ½ of the total points.
- ❖ Overall message
- ❖ Overall effectiveness
- ❖ Originality
- ❖ Universal appeal

Contestants are encouraged to post their videos on their own Facebook pages and to direct friends, family, etc. to the Miss Klamath County-Miss City of Sunshine page to vote. We also encourage you to post anti-bullying tips on your own pages and on our pageant page.
